How to create a sports group under ISA?

- Goals: represent students interested in a particular sport and its relevant tournaments.
- <u>Objective</u>: Provide an environment for like-minded enthusiasts amongst RSU (Rīga Stradiņš University) students

How to start the Sports Group step by step:

- 1. Have a general idea of how training sessions and competitions are supposed to look like. For this, contact the <u>Sports and Integration Office</u> and get the <u>Sport Group Statues</u>.
- 2. Inform yourself about training facilities, request their offers, or ask for exclusive offers for you.
- 3. Contact the ISA Sports and Integration Office to arrange a meeting with us.
 - a. Sports Group Statues need to be discussed.
- 4. Conduct a Google/ Microsoft Form on how many students are interested, what they are interested in/ what you can offer, etc. (depending on the Sport).
- 5. Present your ideas, findings, and possible issues to the Sports and Integration Office.
- 6. Present your final proposal to the ISA Board during a Board Meeting, to get approval of the sports group.
- 7. Once ISA has approved, it will be/can be presented to the Council and a budget can be asked.
 - O What you should have:
 - Social media promotion media (e.g., Facebook group, WhatsApp group, Instagram pages, etc.)
 - A logo for the sports group
 - A training facility/ place
 - At least a board member, the President, and as per wish of the group, other positions can be elected (e.g., Treasurer).
